RAISING SUPPORT FOR YOUR SUMMER MISSION TRIP

WHEN DO I BEGIN?

- NOW! IMMEDIATELY.
- GOAL: To have Most of your support raised over the Christmas Break.

WHERE DO I BEGIN?

Here are a few suggestions to help you as you seek to **communicate your desire to go on** the *GFBM Summer Missions Trip* this summer. Keep in mind that **communicating your** burdens and needs during the CHRISTMAS BREAK is IMPERATIVE!

- Show your teams website
- Give your testimony
- Send out your letters
- Make phone calls
- Write emails

WORK HARD, PRAY HARD, and TRUST HARD!

A. There are two important steps in communicating your needs to others:

Step One: Making a Contact List

Begin by compiling a list of as many people as you know.

- HOME Church contacts, both past members and present church members, your Pastor, Youth Pastor and workers, Sunday School teachers, children's ministry leaders, etc
- Relatives. Grandparents, uncles and aunts, cousins, brothers and sisters, and of course, parents.
- **Friends**. Roommates, suitemates, floor leaders, and consider those with whom you have shared hobbies, sports, or other interests.
- OTHER Contacts. Don't forget your teachers, Dorm Supervisor, doctors, dentists, those whom you have worked for as an employee.

<u>Helpful suggestion</u>: Ask someone close to you, a parent or friend, to review your list. They'll often can think of people you've forgotten.

Step Two: Communicating to those on your Contact List

The #1 method is One-on-one communication followed by phone calls, letters, and presentations.

As much as possible make **personal contacts** with as many of those on your contact list as you can

- 1. to share your burden
- 2. to tell them how **they** can be a part of the Lord's work through what you'll be doing this summer.
- 3. Then tell them you will be sending them a letter.

B. Keys to Raising Support:

Rule #1: Whether you are making a personal visit, calling on the phone, or giving a presentation, always **seek to communicate**

- What you will be doing and
- How they (as your supporters) can be part of God's work!
- Where you are going, when you are going, why you are going, and with whom you are going.

Rule #2: When giving your presentation or a brief testimony about the Missions trip always **STAY POSITIVE** and **BE SPECIFIC.**

- 1. State that you are part of a team sponsored by Youth Outreach Ministries.
- 2. INFORM SUPPORTERS:
 - That the <u>FINANCIAL DONATIONS</u> given through YOM are: tax deductible and will be receipted.
 - They will need the name of your team, AND YOM's address
- 3. DONATIONS

Checks

- to be MADE OUT TO Youth Outreach Ministries
- They need to write the students name and team name in the MEMO space on the check. (So that the money goes to the right person!)

Online

- Go to www.yomteams.com/Donate
- 4. The trip is to encourage and help missionaries through
 - Tract distribution,
 - Bible Clubs,
 - Medical Clinics.
 - Evangelistic Campaigns,
 - Puppet Ministries
 - Church Services.
 - Public School Outreaches and more.
- 5. State that you are going on a summer mission trip because
 - God HAS directed you to do so.
 - Share a Bible verse God has given to you
 - Give your testimony on how He has led you to make this decision.
- **6. BE SPECIFIC** in communicating the following:
 - a. The exact **amount of funds** you need for the trip.
 - b. The time deadline by which money is needed
 - c. State the **purpose for the funds**:

(for airfare, lodging, food, transportation in the country, country exit fees, missionary supplies, ministry materials, etc.)

- d. How they can help.
 - PRAY for you and your team as you prepare
 - PRAY as you go and serve.
 - 1. Effective language skills,
 - 2. Protection for health and in traveling
 - 3. For souls to be saved and missionaries encouraged
 - Give whatever God lays on their heart
 - Donate missionary items, Bible, tracts, etc.
